UA Bovine Researcher Receives ASTA Grant

The Arkansas Science & Technology Authority (Authority) recently issued a grant of \$30,718.00 to Dr. David L. Kreider, effective May 31, 1995.

Dr. Kreider is researching "Effects of Oxytocin on LH Release from the Bovine Anterior Pituitary" at the Department of Animal Sciences, University of Arkansas, Fayetteville.

The Authority's Board of Directors approved funding of the proposal, Resolution No. 95-38, May 19, 1995. The award is for a one-year period.
